

## REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTENT

## Due: Friday, August 30, 2013

A letter of intent is required for all organizations that plan to submit a proposal. Please note that organizations submitting a letter of intent may not be invited to submit a full proposal – an invitation to apply is required and will be issued by NP on or before September 13, 2013. When submitting your letter, please include the following:

- Letterhead of the submitting organization
- Project title
- Brief project description (maximum 1000 words see below)
- Contact Information for Fall 2013 IDA Project Inquiries

## **Project Description**

We ask that the Letters of Inquiry be short and simple. We would like information on the proposed plan to deliver IDAs – including identification of an existing Fiduciary Organization (FO) that would be a good partner in the project delivery, or suggestions on administrative alternatives to the current FO model.

While short and simple, Letters of Inquiry should include:

- Current work
- Demographics and geographic locations of the individuals to be served
- Interest and experience in providing IDAs
- Expected capacity for IDA accounts
- Any leveraged resources your organization brings to this work
- Any relationship you have to existing partners and/or thoughts on preferred partnerships
